Call to Order

Statement of Meeting Procedures. Welcome to the Northern Sonoma County Air Pollution Control District's ("NSCAPCD" or "District") Board of Directors meeting. If you wish to speak on an issue not appearing on the agenda, you may do so during the public comment period. However, please note that the Board is not permitted to take action on topics addressed under public comment. All items that are listed on the agenda will be open for public comments before final action is taken. The Board requests that you state your name and association for the record before you speak. Be aware that there is a 5-minute time limit per speaker, and the Chairperson has the discretion to limit the total discussion time on any item. Please place all cell phones in silent mode. Thank you for your participation and cooperation.

[5] **Approval of Minutes:** November 9, 2022, Regular meeting.

- [15] 1. **Action Item: Required Administrative Items, Including 2023/24 Board Meeting Schedule and Elections.** Meeting schedule, locations, and times must be established for calendar year 2023/24 at the February 8th Board meeting. In addition, a new Chairperson and Vice Chairperson must be elected as existing terms expire after February 8, 2023. Resolution #23-01 will set the meeting dates and locations, and Resolution #23-02 will appoint the new Chairperson and Vice Chairperson.
- [15] 2. **Action Item: Legislative Platform for 2023.** District Counsel and APCO presentation. Counsel will provide an overview of the developing legislative session; review the principles of the District's ongoing legislative platform; and receive Board input, if necessary. Resolution #23-03 will adopt the District's 2023 legislative platform.

- [10] 3. **Information Item: Revised PM-2.5 Standard.** Under federal law, the EPA must periodically re-evaluate the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) and readjust them as necessary to provide an adequate margin of protection, including for sensitive persons. EPA recently provided notice and opened public comment for its adoption of a more stringent PM-2.5 standard.

- [10] 5. **Board Member Announcements.** Board Members may report on their activities at this time.
