Action Item: Grant Incentive Program Opportunities.** The District team will provide a review of its ongoing incentive programs including woodstove replacement, EV chargers, and FARMER and Moyer program diesel equipment replacements. Opportunities for the District's Go Green! and CALeVIP program enhancement will be discussed in addition to an option for a FARMER-funded zero emissions agricultural equipment demonstration project.

[15] **3. Information Item: Community Air Monitoring Programs.** The APCO will present an overview of its emerging community air monitoring activities. In response to [Assembly Bill \(AB\) 617 \(C. Garcia, Chapter 136, Statutes of 2017\)](#), CARB established the Community Air Protection Program (CAPP) which includes community air monitoring and community emissions reduction programs. The District has received two small CARB CAPP grants and is developing community air monitoring programs that are preparing for launch.
